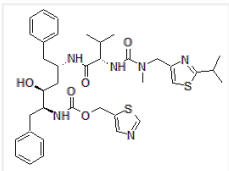
Biological Data

Potentially binds and inhibits the CEP_C30 (coronavirus endopeptidase C30) of SARS-CoV-2 and when used with lopinavir has shown to improve animal models of MERS-CoV. Also shows antitumour activity and induces apoptosis.
